5 Stars = SUPERIOR Awarded to an Assisted Living Facility (ALF) when: Positive Physical Approach training is documented for each employee ☐ Weekly / monthly Skill Building for each employee (Hand-under-hand/VVT) ☐ Managing Difficult Behaviors Coaching is documented for every employee 4 Stars = ABOVE AVERAGE Awarded to an Assisted Living Facility (ALF) when: Positive Physical Approach training is documented for each employee Weekly and monthly Skill Building is documented for each employee 3 Stars = AVERAGE Awarded to an Assisted Living Facility (ALF) when: Positive Physical Approach training is documented for each employee 2 Stars = BELOW AVERAGE Awarded to an Assisted Living Facility (ALF) when: Positive Physical Approach training is NOT documented for each employee 1 Star = INFERIOR Awarded to an Assisted Living Facility (ALF) when:
